**Municipality of Nestos (Greece)** 



The Municipality of Nestos <u>https://dimosnestou.gov.gr/</u> is a Greek local public authority situated in the northern part of Greece, in Southern Europe. It was established in **2011** by the merger of 3 pre-existing municipalities (Keramoti, Oreinos and Chrysoupoli). The seat of the municipality is the town **Chrysoupoli** where about 30% of the population lives and all other settlements are villages. The Municipality of Nestos has an area of more that ~ 7 hund. square kilometres with population of ~ 22 thous. inhabitants and it was named after the river Nestos, which flows to its eastern borders.







#### **Municipality of Nestos (Greece)**

The area of the Municipality of Nestos is located in the administrative Region of East Macedonia and Thrace, within the regional unit of Kavala (Greece) near to the island of Thassos (Greece). The Municipality of Nestos has a rich mountain with traditional villages and productive **agricultural zone**, tremendous beaches, enchanting deep forests, chestnuts, invigorating running waters, picturesque coastline and paths. To this exceptional puzzle are added the the Delta of river Nestos, Keramoti with its emerald sea water and **fish industry**.







#### Municipality of Nestos (Greece)

The area around the river Nestos is full of history, which dates back to the Paleolithic era. Due to large-scale irrigation projects, Chrysoupoli is now the center of **agricultural production** on the west side of the delta of Nestos. Agricultural cooperatives units standardize and export a large number of agricultural products to foreign markets. For the first time, and the **geothermal sector** of Nestos is operated by a company specializing in the production of ornamental and horticultural plants, and the development of manufacturing units continued, including the famous local alcohol distillery of Babatzim.







#### **Municipality of Nestos (Greece)**

• Today the Municipality of Nestos area is dominated by the agricultural cultivation of corn, rice, watermelon, beans, apricots, peaches and potatoes (mainly in the Lekani area). Nestos's kiwis and asparagus are considered to be of high quality and are the most important exported agricultural products. In the mountainous settlements of the village Lekani, with large pastures, organic livestock is still flourishing. In addition, the Municipality of Nestos is also a major transit hub, as the Kavala International Airport "Alexander the Great" operates within its borders, as well as the Port of Keramoti, through which the sea transport of goods and passengers by ship is ensured to the nearby Aegean island of Thassos.







#### Municipality of Nestos (Greece)

In the lagoons of **Keramoti** (villages of Vassova, Eratino, Agiasma) the hatcheries of **fish** with sea bream, crabs, mussels, sardines and mullets stand out. Near the village of **Avramilia** are cultivated vineyards that produce high quality **grapes and wine** (Chardonnay, Syrah, Merlot, Malagouzia, Mount Athos, Assyrtiko and Sauvignon) while **Monastiraki** produces high quality of local **honey**. The river Nestos is the natural border between the adimistrative units of Macedonia and Thrace in Greece.







**Municipality of Nestos (Greece)** 



There are 2 hydroelectric dams along the Greek side, called Thisavros and Platanovrisi. The famous Delta of Nestos occupies a large area in the prefectures of Kavala and Xanthi. The Delta of Nestos has been acclaimed a Wetland of International Significance under NATURA 2000 and it is protected by the Ramsar Convention.







**Municipality of Nestos (Greece)** 

Agricultural sector around the river of Nestos is a source of life and work for the people of the surrounding areas. The Municipality of Nestos is so much excited to participate in the BRIDGES event by contributing to the achievement of sustainable joint results and outputs by finding common solutions to increase CB trade opportunities in the agricultural and connected sectors and promote business and entrepreneurship within the Black Sea Basin.



# Activity A.T2.1 Organisation of the event ("BRIDGES") in Greece

The Municipality of Nestos (Greece) will organize a 2day event -called "BRIDGES" on 21-22 Oct 2022 where sellers from its region will meet buyers from the other partners' regions in predefined, confidential, 30-minutes meetings in order to discuss and identify the potential for their collaboration. The list of the meetings will be generated by the host partner according a matching process based on the information included in the buyers' and sellers' questionnaires (A.T1.3).

The list and the time schedule of the meetings will be sent to the participants at least 2 weeks before the event. Full lists of **buyers and sellers** from all regions and other informative material will be included in a vade mecum given to the participants upon their registration. The meetings will take place in **individual tables** (one per each buyer) according to the time schedule. Last minute meetings are also possible upon request to the secretariat.

The SMEs meetings will be monitored by the Municipality of Nestos (Greece) on a sampling basis. Interpreters hired by the Municipality of Nestos (Greece) will facilitate the communication between partners and sellers from different countries.
